- 4) In what areas are you struggling to work out your salvation? How can your group pray for you?
- 5) Why are complaining and arguing so damaging in the Christian community? (v. 14)
- 6) Where do you struggle with complaining? Can you identify a deeper heart desire that leads to this struggle?
- 7) How does Paul's metaphor of his life as a liquid offering help you to understand the path of obedient suffering?
- 8) What is encouraging to you about how Paul described Timothy? (v. 19-24)
- 9) What is encouraging to you about how Paul described Ephaphroditus? (v.25-30)
