 - d. Confess your sins after forgiving others
 - e. Ask for God's spiritual protection
5. How is viewing our prayers like phone calls to God helpful or unhelpful?
6. Read 1 Thessalonians 5:17, Romans 12:12, and Luke 18:1. What do we learn about prayer from these verses and how well are you practicing that kind of prayer?
7. What is your takeaway from this week's message and how will you respond to it this week?
