- 4. Andrew shared that "We are most content when we are most surrendered to Jesus." Can you share about a time you found this to be true (or, possibly, not true) in your own life?
- 5. What are some of the treasures you seek that keep you from surrendering fully to Jesus?
- 6. "We find true contentment in Jesus' ultimate devotion to us." What are some of the ways that you have recently experienced Jesus' devotion to you?
- 7. Andrew closed with a challenge to speak the truth in love. Is there an opportunity you might have to speak the truth in love and thus help someone find contentment in Jesus?
