1. Share about a time when you searched for something that was difficult to find. Maybe it was a lost item, a hidden treasure, or an elusive item you desired.
2. Jesus responds to the man's question, "What must I do to inherit eternal life?" not with a gospel presentation, but a question of his own and list of commands. What are some of the reasons you think Jesus responds in this way?
3. Jesus looked intently at the man in this passage. Can you recall a memorable moment of eye contact from your own life?
4. Andrew shared that "We are most content when we are most surrendered to Jesus." Can you share about a time you found this to be true (or, possibly, not true) in your own life?
5. What are some of the treasures you seek that keep you from surrendering fully to Jesus?
6. "We find true contentment in Jesus' ultimate devotion to us." What are some of the ways that you have recently experienced Jesus' devotion to you?
7. Andrew closed with a challenge to speak the truth in love. Is there an opportunity you might have to speak the truth in love and thus help someone find contentment in Jesus?
