1. Share a time when you did or said something small that ended up having a big impact.
2. Jesus didn't ignore people's physical or spiritual needs but ministered to both. Why do you think he didn't just focus on spiritual needs?
3. While Jesus was modeling ministry for his followers, he asked them to pray for more workers. Why do you think Jesus asked them to pray for more workers when they would end up being sent out as workers?
4. What does it mean when Jesus says the harvest is great? What does it mean to be a worker in God's fields?
5. What typically holds people back from being a worker for God? Is there anything holding you back?
6. Jesus saw the crowds and had compassion on them because they needed spiritual guidance. What are some ways we can get out to "see the crowds" and grow in our compassion for people?
7. Adam gave us a challenge to go serve people in need but not to ignore their spiritual needs while meeting other needs. Why is it sometimes easier to meet physical needs instead of spiritual needs? How can we do both well?
