- 1. Share about a time you were reunited with someone you love after being apart for a long time.
- 2. Why is it significant that Jesus gives us a personal and visible image of the invisible God?
- 3. Both John and Paul emphasize that Jesus is the Creator of all things (John 1:1-4, Colossians 1:15-17). Why do you think it was important for the original audience of these documents to understand this? Are there any implications for us today in knowing that Jesus was the person of the Trinity directly involved in creation?
- 4. Paul says in Colossians 1:17 that Jesus continues to hold all things together. Does understanding this truth have any impact on your faith in Jesus or your hope for the future?
- 5. Paul's primary concern is that the believers will put Christ in the center of their lives and stay focused on him. What is one way you can avoid things that distract from Jesus and stay centered on Christ in your daily life?
- 6. Colossians 1:19-20 says that Jesus made peace with everything and reconciled everything to Himself. How can it be that everything is reconciled and at peace if not everyone believes in Jesus and is saved?
- 7. Is there an area of your life where Christ does not currently have first place? What would it look like for Jesus to be first in that area?
