1. When a person becomes a follower of Jesus, what changes about their life?
2. Which of the five “terms of service” for salvation shared on Sunday was the most meaningful to you?
3. What does it mean to be spiritually circumcised? How does this provide freedom for believers in Jesus? Why doesn’t it result in perfect people who never sin right away?
4. What is the significance of being buried with Christ and raised to new life in Him? How does this impact our identity as Christians?
5. In what way is salvation like paying off a debt? How might this image of salvation as debt forgiveness impact the way we live? How could it impact our relationships with others and with God?
6. Why is it important that Jesus disarmed the spiritual rulers and authorities? What power did they have before and what did they lose because of Jesus’ victory on the cross?
7. Adam talked about our tendency to “put the grave clothes back on.” What did he mean by this? In what ways have you struggled with putting the grave clothes back on? How can we help each other daily put on the new self made possible by Christ?
