7. “To enjoy the new life, get close to the Creator!” How can we get to know our Creator better?
8. In Colossians 3:11, Paul broke down the barriers of race and class in the body of Christ. How should we treat people who come to our church who are very different from us? Why should there be no barriers of race or class in the church?
