- 1. Have you ever gone through a fashion phase you now regret?
- 2. Paul talks about heavenly values as if they are clothes that we can put on and take off. What does this look like in your life? What are some ways you can intentionally put on the right values and take off the wrong ones?
- 3. Look at Colossians 3:12-14. Which of the things Paul tells believers to put on is the most natural for you? Which one is the least natural?
- 4. Why does Paul single out love in Colossians 3:14 as being more important than the previous list of things to put on? Why are they not all equally important?
- 5. Colossians 3:15 teaches us that when the peace of Christ is in charge of our hearts, the body of Christ has peace. What does this say about personal responsibility for individual believers and the impact on the church as a whole?
- 6. Can you think of any stories in the Bible where the sin of an individual affected a larger group?
- 7. Paul finishes this section with, "and always be thankful." In what ways do the values from the previous few verses contribute to our thankfulness?
- 8. Have you ever been the recipient of an act of love from another believer that greatly encouraged you? What are some creative ways believers can help build each other up in love?
