2. What insights do you get when considering the different phrasing of Colossians 3:17 between the NIV and the NLT: “do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus,” and “do it as a representative of the Lord Jesus,” respectively?
3. We can’t represent Jesus well if we’re not filled with the message of Christ as it says in verse 16. What does it mean to have lives filled with the message about Christ in all its richness?
4. Verse 16 says, “Teach and counsel each other with all the wisdom he gives.” When has a brother or sister in Christ shared wisdom from God in a specific area of your life? When have you shared wisdom from God with another brother or sister in Christ?
5. What could you do to become better at teaching and counseling others with the wisdom God gives? What step could you take this week?
6. What songs best reflect the message about Christ to you? What specific lyrics come to mind?
7. What is the main message that you take from Colossians 3:16-17?
