- 5. How did the rich man in the parable describe his problem? (v. 17-18
- 6. What was the faulty reasoning in this man's assessment and plan? (v19)
- 7. How might this man's choices have been different had he known his life was to be taken? (v. 20)
- 8. How does the reality that none of us have the promise of tomorrow change the way we think about the riches of this world?
- 9. What does it mean to be rich in your relationship with God? Discuss the various attitudes, actions, and speech that create wealth that lasts beyond this life.
- 10. Does this parable challenge you in any specific way? If so, how and what will you do in response?
