1. This week we are launching into a new series where we will be looking at some fascinating questions: *Can I trust science and the Bible? Why doesn't God answer my prayers? I'm a Christian and still have doubts - is that okay?* What question(s) are you excited to talk about in this series? What other questions would you like to add?
2. Last week we looked at the question, "Does the Bible really say there's only one way to God?" In what ways do you connect personally with this question?
3. One of the main points was that **we are created in God's image**. How does this impact the way we interact with those with different perspectives?
4. Another main point was that **we are broken by sin and guilty of sin**. Take some time to read Romans 1:18-21 and Romans 1:28-32. This is an intense section of Scripture! But what can you relate to in this passage when you honestly look at your own life?
5. We also talked about how salvation is **by grace alone, through faith alone, in Christ alone**. Yet all of us are tempted to try to find salvation in something or someone other than Christ. What are some of the pursuits, people, or practices where you are tempted to find "salvation?"
6. Think of one person who needs to hear the gospel in your relational network. What's one practical step you could take to share Jesus with them?
