

Maintenance Engineer

Job Description

Summary

The Maintenance Engineer's primary responsibility is maintaining an optimal space for the disciple-making activities that take place on our campus. This includes evaluating maintenance needs and performing needed maintenance tasks.

Structure

This position is a full-time, hourly position of approximately 40 hours per week. The Maintenance Engineer is part of the Facilities team and reports directly to the Facilities Manager.

Responsibilities

- Evaluate church property for maintenance needs on a regular basis.
- Perform preventative maintenance on buildings, including HVAC, structural needs, electrical systems, and plumbing.
- Work with the Facilities Manager to plan and carry out building and equipment improvements and upgrades.
- Work with outside vendors as needed to meet maintenance and improvement needs.
- Maintain church property, to include: HVAC, building maintenance, landscaping projects.
- Check in with departments on a regular basis to ascertain facility needs.
- Help to train new people in overall maintenance skills.
- Work with volunteers to guide them on projects and to make sure they are working safely.
