- 4. Adam spoke about keeping your circle "as small as possible for as long as possible." What happens when this circle does not stay small?
- 5. What role does the gospel play in confrontation and reconciliation? How can we keep the gospel at the center of our conflicts?
- 6. Write out a prayer thanking the Lord for his forgiveness; ask for the strength to forgive others, and the strength to ask for forgiveness from others.
