



## Wise Choices in Foggy Conditions

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1. What is a decision you've faced that seemed harder than it should have?
2. How can we be better prepared for life's difficult decisions before we are faced with them?
3. Adam shared six steps to making wise decisions in foggy circumstances:
  - a. They were constantly in community and prayer together (verse 14)
  - b. They accepted the will of God even when it seemed troubling (verse 16)
  - c. They looked to Scripture for guiding principles (verse 20)
  - d. They used common sense when they didn't have clear direction (verses 21-23)
  - e. They prayed for God's wisdom and will in their decision (verses 24-25)
  - f. They made a decision and took action (verse 26)
