

## **Wise Choices in Foggy Conditions**

- 1. What is a decision you've faced that seemed harder than it should have?
- 2. How can we be better prepared for life's difficult decisions before we are faced with them?
- 3. Adam shared six steps to making wise decisions in foggy circumstances:
  - a. They were constantly in community and prayer together (verse 14)
  - b. They accepted the will of God even when it seemed troubling (verse 16)
  - c. They looked to Scripture for guiding principles (verse 20)
  - d. They used common sense when they didn't have clear direction (verses 21-23)
  - e. They prayed for God's wisdom and will in their decision (verses 24-25)
  - f. They made a decision and took action (verse 26)
