1. When have you witnessed the power of the wind?
2. The OT and NT words for “spirit” can also mean “wind.” Jesus gives significance to this dual meaning in John 3:6-8. How does this double meaning assist us in understanding how we experience the work of the Holy Spirit?
3. Read Acts 2:1-12.
4. What did the believers experience and see when the Holy Spirit was poured out upon them?
5. How did the filling of the Spirit at Pentecost signify a change in how believers relate to God?
6. The disciples were given the ability to speak in the languages of those in the crowd. Based on this account, what was the purpose of this supernatural enablement?
7. How should the witness to “all nations” in this passage encourage and challenge us in our ministry today?
8. Read Acts 2:13-21.
9. Peter declares that the outpouring of the Holy Spirit is the fulfillment of this prophecy in Joel. With that in mind, how should we understand the term “last days?”
10. According to verse 21, what is the hope found in the coming of the Spirit?
