3. We live in a time of decreasing commitment to the local church. A recent survey found that only 68% of American Evangelical adults agreed that "Every Christian has an obligation to join a local church." What are some of the reasons we are seeing less commitment to the church right now?
4. In the sermon we talked about how important it is to be **empowered by the Holy Spirit and transformed by God's grace**. Can you think of a time in your life when you've felt empowered by the Spirit or transformed by grace?
5. Take some time as a group (or individually) to read 2 Corinthians 8:7-15 and 1 Timothy 6:17-20, which talk about being surrendered with our possessions. What stands out to you from these passages?
6. In Acts, we see that the early believers were **committed and surrendered, empowered and transformed**. Which of these words most applies to how God is currently at work in your life?
