



God's Power For His People

1. What's one area of life where you feel like you need power from God?
2. One of the most incredible passages in the Bible about God's power (and how he shares that power with us) is Isaiah 40:25-31. Read this passage together as a group. If possible, also give everyone a chance to read this passage silently to themselves. What words or phrases stand out from this passage?

Leader Note - the next questions, (3-5) are similar and connected. You may want to have the group read all three questions at once and then have each person answer one. Or, if you have time, feel free to discuss all 3.

3. On Sunday we talked about how God has the power to *transform* his people. What's one way you have experienced this transformation in your life?
4. We also talked about how God has power to *protect* his people. Can you think of a time where you experienced God's protection?
5. Finally - we talked about how God has power to *guide* his people. Can you think of a time where God guided you in a powerful way?
6. As part of the sermon we looked at the following quote from John Murray:

“God's working in us is not suspended because we work, nor our working suspended because God works. Neither is the relationship strictly one of cooperation as if God did his part and we did ours... God works in us and we also work. *But the relation is that because God works we work.*”

What's one way that you need to respond because of how God is at work in your life?
