- 5. What are some specific ways you could build bridges toward a non-Christian through good works or being a good neighbor in your neighborhood or workplace? Who is the one person God seems to be putting in your path?
- 6. Do people listening to you think that you think you walk in wonderful light? How do our actions and words either draw people toward or away from believing the gospel?
