- 5. Describe the nature of the charges and punishment Paul and Silas received.
- 6. What was the response of Paul and Silas to being imprisoned? How does their response compare with your response to hardship?
- 7. How did Paul and Silas help the jailer to know Christ? What evidence is described that points to his genuine conversion?
- 8. What do you make of Paul's challenge to the magistrates upon their release (v 35-39)? When is it good to accept injustice, and when is it good to stand up for one's rights (based on this passage)?
