1. Where do you have the best opportunities to connect with people who don't know Jesus?
2. Do you feel able to share your faith and the gospel message with people in conversation? What would help you grow in that area?
3. Paul contextualized his message to his audience so they could understand it better. What does this look like in our modern context? What does this look like for your relationships?
4. Paul made Jesus the main point of his message. What types of points do Christians sometimes focus on that can distract people from Jesus if emphasized too much?
5. Some people accepted Paul's message, while others rejected it. How does this help us anticipate the potential responses of people to our sharing and deal with the outcomes?
6. Paul and Silas faced severe consequences for telling people about Jesus, yet they did it anyway! How can we learn from their boldness?
7. Paul and Silas were accused of "turning the world upside down" with their message. How would you like to turn your world upside down? What actions could give you a greater impact than you have now?
