1. Think about your own faith. Would you consider it reasonable? What is the rationale for your faith?
2. In what ways is your faith dangerous? How do you think that should change in the future?
3. Would you say your faith is intriguing to nonbelievers? Why or why not?
4. Although our faith is reasonable, it is also rooted in the supernatural. Read Acts 17:24-25 and share what stands out to you from this passage.
5. Take 2-3 minutes in quiet to personally reflect on this question (writing down some notes may help): If you imagine your life as a mountain-top garden with altars for the things you worship and benches for the places you spend time, what gets worshiped, and what gets a place of prominence for you? Are there altars of worship that should just be benches? Is the altar of faith in God in the right place? Does everything else in your garden point to your faith?

After giving this quiet thought for a couple of minutes, share with each other what you've learned about yourself.
