- 4. If your group has time, take a few minutes and have people read the following verses connected to the concept of "conscience." 1 Samuel 24:4-6, Romans 2:14-16, 1 Corinthians 4:3-5, and Hebrews 9:14. What stands out to you from these verses about our conscience?
- 5. Part of the message focused on Acts 24:16, which says, "I always try to maintain a clear conscience before God and all people." What's one area of your life where God may be leading you to listen to your conscience?
- 6. What does it look like for you to trust the sufficiency of God's grace when you face high stakes situations?
- 7. What's your biggest take away from Sunday's message (or from this discussion)? How do you need to respond?
