- 1. In preparation for the group discussion, read Acts 27:1-28:10. Look for principles that we can learn from the text.
- 2. Reflect on a time when you faced an unexpected challenge. How did you respond? Did you see any opportunities for growth or ministry in that situation, similar to Paul's unplanned mission trip?
- 3. Paul's respectful and kind attitude towards Julius and others significantly influenced how they treated him and listened to him. How can your attitude in difficult circumstances affect those around you, including those who may not share your beliefs?
- 4. Paul looked for ways to serve others, even when he was a prisoner. What opportunities can we find to serve others in our current circumstances, regardless of our limitations?
- 5. Paul's leadership and faith influenced the entire crew and passengers. Discuss ways you can demonstrate leadership and positively influence those in your own "ship" (family, workplace, community) toward faith in God, especially during crises.
- 6. What other principles did you notice in the text you read?
