### Read Psalm 46:1-11

1. *Have you ever experienced a situation where gaining clarity led to more questions or uncertainties? How did you navigate those new challenges?*
2. *In what ways do you relate to the idea of a personal “earthquake” or “mountain crumbling” in your own life? How did you cope with it?*
3. *How do you find trust and confidence in God when facing circumstances that seem out of your control? Can you share an example from your own life?*
4. *How does Psalm 46’s portrayal of God as a refuge and strength challenge or reinforce your understanding of God’s role in times of trouble?*
5. *Verses 4-7 contrast the chaos of nations with the security of God’s city. What does this imagery teach us about the stability and peace God offers in contrast to worldly upheaval?*
6. *How does the concept of the church as a “city that cannot be destroyed” influence your view of your involvement and commitment to your faith community?*
7. *How does the idea of God commanding “Be still” and ceasing our efforts impact your understanding of human striving and divine control?*

8. *In what ways does the future hope of God's complete redemptive plan shape your daily faith and actions?*
