- 4. Daniel and his friends thrived in exile by not isolating themselves from Babylonian culture. How can we be present in today's culture without conforming to it? What are some practical ways to live out Jeremiah 29:7 in our context?
- 5. What does it mean to "work for the peace and prosperity" of a culture that may be at odds with your faith, as Daniel did in Babylon? How does this apply to your work or community involvement?
