- 1. Daniel responded to conflict with "wisdom and discretion" (Daniel 2:14). What does it mean to handle challenges with both wisdom and discretion in today's context?
 - Can you think of a situation where you could have applied more discretion? How would it have changed the outcome?
- 2. In Daniel 2:16, Daniel sought time from the king to find the dream's meaning. Why is patience important when responding to urgent problems?
 - What practical steps can we take to avoid rushing into decisions without adequate time and prayer?
- 3. Daniel's boldness in sharing his faith in front of the king is striking (Daniel 2:27-28). How can we be bold in sharing our faith, even when risky or uncomfortable?
- 4. In Daniel 2:46-47, Nebuchadnezzar recognizes God's power after Daniel interprets the dream. How can we help others recognize God's work in their lives, even if they don't yet believe in Him?
- 5. Daniel's interpretation of the dream pointed to God's ultimate control over history (Daniel 2:21). How does knowing that God is in control bring peace in the face of uncertainty and danger?
