1. Optional icebreaker question: what's your favorite part of fall?
2. King Nebuchadnezzar sets up a gold statue and commands people to worship it. Read through Isaiah 44:10-12 and 19-20. What are some of the idols that people make in our cultural context?
3. In Daniel 3:15 Nebuchadnezzar asks Shadrach, Mesach, and Abednego "What god will be able to rescue you from my power?" When you face challenges, what "gods" do you tend to look to for rescue or help?
4. Shadrach, Mesach, and Abenego are faithful even though it may cost them their lives. Can you think of a time where following Jesus has cost you something?
5. Read Daniel 3:17-18. Is there a place in your life you need to trust God "even if he doesn't" rescue in the way you'd like?
6. In the message, Andrew talked about how our challenges are an opportunity to know God's presence. Can you think of a time where you experienced suffering or persecution and experienced God's presence in a powerful way?
7. What's your biggest takeaway from studying this passage?
