- 1. Reflect on Daniel 12:13: "As for you, go your way until the end. You will rest, and then at the end of the days, you will rise again to receive the inheritance set aside for you."
 - How does God's promise to Daniel at the end of his life challenge the way we view success or fulfillment in this life? What would it look like to live faithfully even if we never see the results of our obedience in our lifetime?
- 2. How does having an eternal perspective shape the way you respond to challenges in your daily life? What practical steps can you take to keep eternity in view while living faithfully in the present?
- 3. Reflect on Daniel's consistent prayer life (Daniel 6:10) and the daily choices that prepared him for extraordinary moments of faith. What "small moments" of faithfulness can you commit to this week?
- 4. Reflect on Daniel 12:8: "I heard what he said, but I did not understand what he meant."
 - Have you ever experienced a season where God's plans didn't make sense? How did you respond? What can we learn from Daniel's trust in God, even when he didn't fully understand?
- 5. Read Hebrews 11:13-16, which speaks of those who lived by faith without receiving what was promised. What promises of God give you hope, even when life feels uncertain?
- 6. Can you identify a time in your life when it felt like your faithfulness wasn't making a difference? How can Daniel's life and God's promises encourage you to persevere?
- 7. What kind of legacy do you want your faithfulness to leave for those around you?
