



## **What We Believe About God: The Loving Community - Discussion Questions**

- How much do you struggle with the tension of faith vs. certainty? How comfortable are you with trusting God where full understanding isn't possible?
- How does the submission, authority, and unity within the Trinity help us to think about those same principles in our own relationships (friendships, marriage, church, the workplace, etc.)?
- What are the risks, spiritually or practically, of getting our picture of God wrong? Can you think of any examples in your own life?
- How does our view of the Trinity affect our view of the cross?

- Before going to the cross, Jesus prays that future believers would be united in the same way He is united with the Father. What stands in the way of that kind of unity, and what might it look like to move toward it?
- Community is not simply something God does, but who God is. How does that truth challenge individualistic approaches to faith and church involvement?
- The message ended with three invitations: connect, serve, and invite others in. Which of those feels most challenging for you right now, and what is one practical step you could take this week in response?
