4. Read 1 Corinthians 9:20-21. How does the law of Christ, which emphasizes loving God and loving our neighbor, guide our decision-making in situations not explicitly addressed in the Bible?
5. Do you have any personal stories of a time you realized you (or someone else) were treating a conviction like a doctrine or dogma?
